Children must be 5 years old on or before September 1 to qualify.

- Family may need to provide transportation

Enrollment Steps

- Online student enrollment registration will open in February 2024. Information and instructions will be available on our website at lakeorionschools.org/kindergarten.
- 2. The enrollment registration link will be available on the Central Enrollment webpage at lakeorionschools.org/enroll. Select School Age Enrollment Registration Instructions and then New Student Enrollment 2024-25 to begin.
- 3. Required documents may be uploaded into the enrollment link. In-person appointments are not required but may be scheduled after submitting the enrollment registration. If you prefer to bring your documents in person, you must schedule an appointment.
- 4. Computers are available, if needed, at the Central Enrollment office to complete the enrollment registration.
- Make sure you select the 2024-2025 school year before starting the enrollment registration.

- Current DK students do not need to register for kindergarten.




