Lake Orion High School will be administering the MME State Test to all juniors on March 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011. **In order to graduate from LOHS, students must complete all subject areas of the state required MME TESTING in their junior year**. During the testing period, your student's school schedule will be altered for three days. Below is the schedule your son/daughter will be following on the testing dates.

## March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 (Day One)

All juniors are required to report to their testing rooms by 7:35 AM for the <u>ACT PLUS WRITING</u> portion of the state testing. This test will be completed by 12:35 PM.

Students need to bring a calculator for all 3 days of testing.

## March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 (Day Two)

All juniors are required to report to their testing rooms by 7:35 AM

for the <u>ACT WORKKEYS APPLIED MATHEMATICS</u>, <u>READING FOR INFORMATION</u> and <u>LOCATING INFORMATION</u>. This test will be completed by 10:40 AM. All juniors will have a break for lunch prior to the school day beginning at 11:22 AM for all students.

Bring a Calculator to help with the Math portion of the ACT WorkKeys Test.

All students will attend Periods 1 and 2 only. SCHOOL WILL BEGIN (1<sup>ST</sup> HOUR) AT 11:22 AM FOR ALL 9-12 STUDENTS.

# March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 (Day Three)

All juniors are required to report to their testing rooms by 7:35 AM for the MICHIGAN MATH, SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES TESTING. This test will be completed by 10:15 AM. All juniors will have a break for lunch prior to the school day beginning at 11:22 AM for all students. Bring a Calculator to help with the Math portion of the MME Test.

All students will attend Periods 3 and 4 only. SCHOOL WILL BEGIN (3rd HOUR) AT 11:22 AM FOR ALL 9-12 STUDENTS.

#### TRANSPORTATION

### March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

Juniors who use the school district transportation will be picked up on the usual (Mon., Tues., Thur., Fri.) time schedule. No school for 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade students.

#### March <sup>3ra</sup>, 2011

A second bus run will be provided for all other (9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>) grade students approximately 90 minutes after their normal Wednesday AM pick up time.

#### **LAKE ORION GRADUATION REQUIREMENT**

All Lake Orion students are required to take the state mandated **ACT and MME Assessments. These test include: ACT, ACT PLUS WRITING, WORKKEYS APPLIED MATHEMATICS, READING FOR INFORMATION, LOCATING INFORMATION, MICHIGAN MATH, SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES.** This letter serves as a reminder that the spring testing cycle is March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 for all juniors to complete.

- 1. All electronic devices (cell phones, I-pods, laptops, etc.) are banned from all testing environments. **DO NOT bring these items to school on test days. Students will not be allowed to bring them into the classroom where testing will be administered.**

- 3. Each year all LOHS students are provided an account to use the ACT Online Prep. This year ACT Online Prep information was e-mailed to all parents prior to the holiday break.
