A. Essay

A concise essay discussing why you value service to your school and community (approximately 300 words) <u>Do not include your name or other personal information on this document to ensure anonymity during the</u> <u>selection process</u>. Please use single spacing and limit to one page if possible.

B. Additional Service

1. A list and brief description of any additional service to Lake Orion High School and/or the community at large

C. Verification

- 1. A copy of your college, university, trade or technical school admission letter
- 2. A transcript of service learning hours
