### **AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP: HIGH SCHOOL**

This scholarship has been established to recognize a student who has demonstrated commitment to the goals of scholastic achievement, community service, and responsible citizenship toward which our school aspires. Students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or better (through 3<sup>rd</sup> term of senior year)
- ✓ Admission to a college, university, trade or technical school
- ✓ Involvement in extra-curricular activities, school and community service

### **OUTSTANDING SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP: HIGH SCHOOL**

This scholarship has been established to recognize a student who has contributed outstanding service to Lake Orion High School through his/her high school years. Students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Cumulative grade point average of 2.2 or better (through 3<sup>rd</sup> term of senior year)
- ✓ Admission to a college, university, trade or technical school
- ✓ Involvement in extra-curricular activities and community service

### **VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP: HIGH SCHOOL**

This scholarship was established to recognize outstanding performance and achievement in a vocational or technical program. Students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Cumulative grade point average of 2.2 or better (through 3<sup>rd</sup> term of senior year)
- ✓ Admission to a college, university, trade or technical school

### **ARTS AND LITERATURE SCHOLARSHIP: HIGH SCHOOL**

This scholarship was established to recognize a student whose academic experience has been enhanced through art, drama, music, dance or literature. Students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Cumulative grade point average of 2.2 or better (through 3<sup>rd</sup> term of senior year)
- ✓ Admission to a college, university, trade or technical school
- ✓ Involvement in an art, drama, music, dance or literature program

### **AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP: LEARNING OPTIONS HIGH SCHOOL**

This scholarship has been established to recognize a student who has demonstrated commitment to the goals of scholastic achievement and responsible citizenship toward which our school aspires. Students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Student must be enrolled in Learning Options High School for two consecutive terms prior to applying for the Ambassador Scholarship.
- ✓ Admission to a college, university, trade or technical school
