School Districts

Most Michigan school districts showed improvement in their spring 2022 statewide test results over the previous year's results.

- On average, from third to seventh grade,
 54.5% of school districts increased their ELA achievement scores and 4% of districts maintained their achievement levels compared to last year.
- On average from third to seventh grade,
 55.9% of school districts increased their math achievement scores and 7.4% of districts maintained their levels.
- In most cases, Lake Orion's results were as good or better.










Is there concern about the 11th grade M-STEP social studies score?


Overall Performance Trends, 2020-2022

A year ago, the district SAEBRS BOY 2021-22 was 88% Low Risk; 10% Some Risk; 2% High Risk. **SAEBRS** has **teachers** mark the frequency with which they observe student displaying various behaviors during the previous month.

A year ago, the district mySAEBRS BOY 2021-22 was 84% Low Risk; 14% Some Risk; 2% High Risk.

mySAEBRS has students use scales to identify how frequently they experience various described behaviors.



mySAEBRS at the High School

- For the first time, the mySaebrs screener will be administered to ninth graders three times this school year.
 - mySAEBRS is a brief and contextually relevant self-rating of student risk for social, emotional and behavioral problems.
 - The screener is comprised of 20 items, each of which relates to a broad scale (Total Behavior) and three subscales: Social Behavior (7 items), Academic Behavior (6 items), and Emotional Behavior (7 items).
 - The first high school screening is planned for the end of November during a homeroom session. It will be followed by MOY and EOY screenings the rest of the year.

Tracking High School Achievement


A district team has been meeting this fall to discuss how we can track high school achievement.

So far, the following has been decided:


- Achievement data for ELA and Math for grades 9-11 will be monitored.
 - We will review data for block and skinny classes at semester.
 - A strong rationale behind this is because these two content areas (ELA & math) align with our approach at the elementary and middle school levels, as well as our district school improvement plan.
- The mySaebrs screener will be administered to ninth graders three times this school year. This will assist with the implementation of a new MTSS system at the high school.
- We will also track the number of students taking
 Advanced Placement classes, along with how many are taking AP tests and passing them.







Summing-up

- In most cases, the district is either improving or maintaining performance when compared to 2021-22 or to county and state results.
 - District **M-STEP scores are up** in ELA, math, and science and down in social studies.
 - District M-STEP scores are above county and state averages.
 - aReading and aMath scores are slightly improved from 2021-22.
 - **PSAT/SAT** scores **dropped** from 2021-22. However, composite SAT scores were well **above the state average**.
 - On a 2022 AP test, **71**% of students scored a **3 or** better.
 - New initiatives:
 - Grades 9-11 achievement data will be collected for ELA and math.
 - Grade 9 will have the mySaebrs screener administered three times this year.
 - Advanced Placement data will also be assessed.
