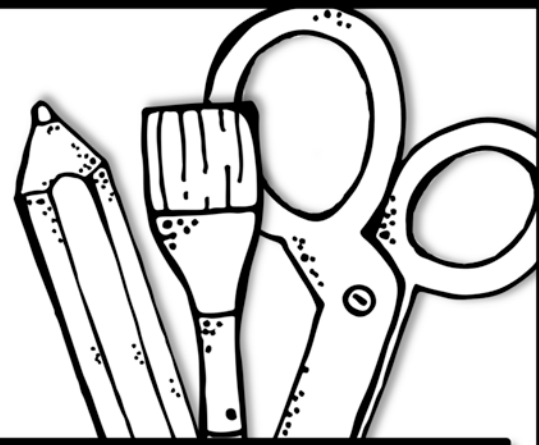


# Suggested School supplies

## Suggested Community Supplies (PLEASE DO NOT LABEL ITEMS)

- 48 Ticonderoga brand pencils - sharpened!
- Headphones \*labeled with name\*
- Crayons (no bigger than 48 count)
- 8- 10 Black Chisel Tip Expo dry-erase markers
- 4 Black Thin Expo dry-erase markers
- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 4-6 glue sticks
