

# First Grade Remote Learning Supply List

Parents, thank you for engaging in this learning partnership with us! The supplies that we expect your child to need for a typical week of remote learning are listed below. We included suggested quantities for this first quarter of school, but how many items students will actually use will vary. Organized and careful students may need fewer supplies, and kids who are harder on their materials or who are more creative might need more. Many of these items may already be in your home and do not need to be purchased new. Writing booklets will be provided, but scrap and printer paper will also be helpful to have on hand if possible. Depending on your situation, you may also wish to invest in a noise canceling headset for use with the iPad. Please do consider how to store these supplies so that they are easy for your child to keep and use independently during remote learning. Thank you!

- crayons (24 or more)
- markers (6 or more)
- scissors
- pencils with erasers and a way to sharpen them (6-8)
- glue sticks (2-3)
- dry erase markers (2-3)
- black pen (1-2)
- composition notebook
- two 2 pocket folders
